H-41.10.1.1 – Unassisted Reboarding

First make sure the motor, outboard or inboard, is turned off and the propeller is not in motion.

The reboarding ladder is located at the starboard aft corner of the boat.

For models with a lid above the ladder: When in the water, use one hand to hold on to the boat with, you might have to pull yourself up so you can see the lid. Take your other hand and lift the lid, opens towards the starboard side. When lid is open, lift the ladder towards you and let it extend out into the water. Close the lid and use the cut-out in the lid as a hand hold to climb up the ladder. When back on the boat, open the lid, fold/compress the ladder back into the compartment, and close the lid back on top of the ladder.

For models with no lid above the ladder: When in the water, use one hand to hold on to the boat with, you might have to pull yourself up so you can see the ladder. Take your other hand and lift the ladder towards you and let it extend out into the water. Use the hand hold in the ladder compartment to assist you in climbing the ladder. When back on the boat fold/compress the ladder back into the compartment.
